



To the Officers and Members of Reciprocating clubs:

The Commodore, Executive and members of the Presqu'ile Yacht Club are pleased to extend reciprocal privileges to your club for 2012

Our policy is to offer the first night free and request a donation of \$20.00 for each subsequent night.

Presqu'ile Yacht Club is a small self-help club located on Presqu'ile Bay (N44.01.52 W77.42.77) approximately 1 and ½ kilometers east of the Brighton Marina.

To enter our club, follow the channel markers leading to/from the Murray Canal. Then turn northwest at the green channel buoy MP11. After a short distance you will see our red and green pipe buoys leading into the Club.

The service dock is reserved for visiting overnight boaters on a first come first served basis. If a member is present you may be directed to a dock if it is vacant. We can generally accommodate boats up to 5' 6" draft. We are pleased to advise that dredging was carried out this past fall in the harbour and the approaches.

We have posted instructions for access to and usage of the Clubhouse. The clubhouse includes a full kitchen, washrooms and showers. Barbecues are also available. If a club member is available when you arrive they will be pleased to assist you with any further needs that you may have. Our deck also offers one of the most serene and picturesque views on the bay looking out over our boats and the marshes alive with waterfowl. The Club has four bicycles available to visitors to access the restaurants that are nearby or to travel in to town. Unfortunately, the convenience store located nearby closed this past year. We look forward to you and your members visiting our club.
